- I. To enhance teaching quality and outcomes, and to recognize outstanding instructors, these Guidelines are established in accordance with the University's "Regulations for the Selection and Recognition of Outstanding Teachers."
- II. The College Committee for the Selection of Outstanding Teachers in Teaching shall be composed as follows:

Convener: The Dean (If the Dean is a candidate, a convener shall be elected from among the representatives of the departments and institutes).

Department/Institute Representatives: Two representatives from each department or institute.

Members of the Selection Committee who are nominated as candidates shall recuse themselves.

The Committee shall convene only when more than one-half of its members are present, and resolutions shall be adopted upon approval by more than one-half of the members present.

- III. Eligibility criteria for candidates for the College Outstanding Teacher in Teaching Award are as follows:
 - 1. Full-time faculty members who have served at the University for at least two years.
 - 2. Faculty members whose teaching hours meet the required minimum and

who have taught courses every semester.

- 3. Full-time faculty members whose teaching evaluation scores for the previous academic year rank within the top 25% of their department or institute. If any individuals on this list have served at the University for fewer than two years, or have received the award within the past five academic years, the next eligible faculty member(s) on the ranking list shall be substituted. Any substituted candidate must have an average course evaluation score higher than the departmental average.
- 4. Faculty members who receive recommendations from at least two peers and the approval of their department or institute head.
- 5. If a nominated candidate has changed units, the department or institute listed in the teaching evaluation results of the previous academic year shall be used as the basis for determination.
- IV. The selection of Outstanding Teachers in Teaching at the College level shall be conducted as follows:

Selection Procedures:

- 1. A list of candidates shall be provided by the University's Academic Services Section.
- 2. The number of award recipients for the year shall be determined and approved by the University.
- 3. The final list of selected candidates shall be decided through deliberation by the Committee.

Recommendation Procedures:

1. The Academic Services Section shall compile statistics on full-time faculty members of the College whose average results in the Teaching Feedback Survey rank within the top 25% of their department or institute for four or more academic years since Academic Year 2000. Those who meet this requirement and have not received a College- or University-level Outstanding Teacher Award within the three years prior to the award year shall be considered candidates for the College Outstanding Teacher in Teaching Award.

- 2. The number of recommended candidates shall be determined through deliberation by the Committee.
- V. The Academic Services Section shall provide evaluation criteria to the Selection Committee for reference in the assessment process.
- VI. Faculty members selected as College Outstanding Teachers in Teaching shall be formally recognized by the Dean at a College Affairs Meeting and awarded a certificate of commendation.
- VII. Any matters not covered in these Guidelines shall be handled in accordance with the University's Regulations for the Selection and Recognition of Outstanding Teachers.
- VIII. These Guidelines shall take effect upon approval by the College Committee for the Selection of Outstanding Teachers in Teaching and confirmation by the College Affairs Meeting.
